








GENDER POLICY AT THE LOCAL LEVEL

Findings of the survey conducted by the Association of Ukrainian Cities in April – May, 2020 within the framework of the USAID Policy for Ukraine's Local Self-Governance Project (PULSE) together with the Strengthening Democracy and Building Trust at Local Level in Ukraine Project implemented by the AUC and the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe and in cooperation with the Partnership for Local Economic Development and Democratic Governance (PLEDDG) Project of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities

839 AUC member communities have participated in the survey




The surveyed communities include 505 consolidated territorial communities











GENDER BALANCE IN COMMUNITIES


Number of communities with 30% to 50% of local council members of the same gender




Number of communities with equal representation of females and males in local councils





Number of communities using gender budgeting




Do local councils implement gender policy?

- supports pilot projects to prepare Charter implementation plans in communities.
